



# Nigerian Institute of Management

## CRITERIA FOR ELECTION INTO COUNCIL OF NIM

The Nigerian Institute of Management is a professional organization comprising members in different managerial capacities, from various professional specializations across sectors. Membership of Council is a leadership position in the Institute requiring exceptional professional attainment and demanding sacrifice. Council membership also demands that individuals be perceived as role models in respect of the standards and values for which the Institute stands. In this respect, Council has decided that its members should meet the criteria set out below: -

1. He/she must be a member of the Institute and must be up to date in his/her financial obligations, such as payment of annual subscriptions and development levy.
2. He/she must avail appropriate measure of Time, Talent and Treasure to the Institute from time to time.
3. He/she must have attained a level in the profession of Management as to command respect of the totality of members of the Institute and the public
4. He/she must possess impeccable image and reputation
5. He/she must have given sterling service to the Nigerian Institute of Management at Council, Committee or National/Branch levels.
6. He/she must have been a member of the Board or the highest policy making organ of reputable organization or its equivalent in the public sector or similar body.
7. He/she must hold a position of such seniority as to engender the respect and confidence of members of a professional organization as the Nigerian Institute of Management.
8. He/she must have a strong track record of integrity and demonstrable selflessness.
9. He/she must have a **clean** track record of **conduct** and **behaviour** and must never have fallen into disrepute or have been indicted in previous or current employment, assignment or responsibility.
